The Role of the Link Health Visitor with Early Years Settings



Supporting Partnership Working in the Early Years

Who are Link Health Visitors?

Link Health Visitors are the named Health Visitors for Early Years Settings and Childminders.

What is the Link Health Visitor role?

The Link Health Visitor is required to visit the setting or meet up with the Lead Childminder for an area termly. The Health Visitor will be able to give information about child development, childhood ailments, immunisations and other matters relating to the general health and well-being of children.

The Link Health Visitor may also be able to give information about other services, and signpost to relevant agencies.

**What happens when the Link Health Visitor visits a setting or meets with the Link Childminder?**

The Link Health Visitor may be able to discuss a scenario, to enable the setting or childminder to make decisions about how to proceed. If the setting has a concern about a particular child, the Link Health Visitor will direct the Early Years practitioner towards the family Health Visitor. The Early Years practitioner should first speak with the parent and gain their consent, before discussing their concern with the named Health Visitor. If the concern is related to child protection, the Early Years setting or the Childminder should refer to Children's Social Care.



The Link Health Visitor should collect the Integrated Review Cohort Record from the settings and share this with the family Health Visitor.

What is our role in the integrated review?

The role of the Link Health visitor is to share information from the integrated review cohort record with children's family Health Visitors, and feedback to the setting or Lead Childminder where appropriate
