**TAUNTON DEANE ORDER 2012
(AMENDMENT No. 8) ORDER 2015**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 , 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 2004"), as amended, and all other enabling powers; and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The County of Somerset Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Unloading and On-street Parking Taunton Deane Order 2012, (hereinafter referred to as "the Order of 2012") shall be amended as follows:-

- a. Appendix A of the Order of 2012 shall be deleted in total and replaced with the revised Appendix A as attached to and set out in Schedule 1 of this Order.

This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd November 2015 and may be cited as The County of Somerset Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Unloading and On-street Parking Taunton Deane Order 2012 (Amendment No.8) Order 2015.
