SCHEDULE Provision of a Cycle Track

- The Cycle Track along Eastwick Road will be 69 metres in length from the cycleway and footway link into Barlinch Close to the boundary of no. 144 Eastwick Road. The existing footway/verge will be widened to 3 metres wide to form a shared segregated footway/cycleway.
- The Cycle Track at Eastwick Road will be 6.5 metres in length and commence opposite the crossing point that lies to the south of no. 144 Eastwick Road. The existing footway will be widened to 3.5 metres to form a shared unsegregated footway/cycleway.
- The Cycle Track at Priorswood Road will be 28 metres in length from Old Priorswood Road to Priorswood Road. The existing footway/verge will be widened to 3 metres wide to form a shared unsegregated footway/cycleway.

These measures are to provide for a proposed cycle link between Nerrols Farm and Priorswood and are promoted in the interests of pedestrian and cyclist safety.
