**THE COUNTY OF SOMERSET (LITTLE LONDON AND FOSSE ROAD)
(OAKHILL) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2016**

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on the 31st January 2016 and may be cited as "Somerset County Council, The County of Somerset (Little London and Fosse Road) (Oakhill) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2016".
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order.

SCHEDULE
30 mph Speed Limit

Little London Oakhill	From a point 155 metres north-west of the centre of its junction with Sunnymead for a distance of approximately 108 metres in a north-easterly direction.
Fosse Road Oakhill	From a point 245 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A367 Bath Road for a distance of approximately 295 metres in a south-easterly direction.
