
Northern Bridgwater Junction Improvements One-way system

- Many options were looked at in order to keep the traffic flowing into and out of Bridgwater and it was concluded that a temporary one-way system is the best option
- A one-way system will minimise the impact on local residents, local businesses and road users and lead to a shorter programme duration, avoiding the busy Christmas period
- The one-way system will be installed for the duration of the two schemes from early 2017 to late summer 2017
