Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for the purpose of maintenance of the road and operations; maintenance of street furniture and infrastructure; supply of gas, water or electricity; agriculture on any land adjacent; the pursuance of statutory powers or duties; vehicles associated with the film production and fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
