

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2017
(THE SOMERSET STAGES CAR RALLY)

Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council intends to make an order in pursuance of the provisions of Section 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of motor vehicles as detailed in the schedules below.

The Order shall come into operation at 0600 hours on Friday 7th April 2017 and will remain in force until 2000 hours on Saturday 8th April 2017.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for emergency vehicles and any vehicles associated with the event with the permission of the Somerset Stages Car Rally Event Organiser.

SCHEDULE 1

Temporary Prohibition of Motor Vehicles between the hours of 0600 and 2000
hours on Saturday the 8th April 2017

Boniton Lane, Dunster	From its junction with the A396 in a southerly direction to its junction with Whitswood Steep (a distance of 580 metres)
Whitswood Steep, Dunster	From its junction with Boniton Lane in a southerly direction to Beech Tree (a distance of 4886 metres)
Couple Cross to Beech Tree Road	From its junction with the Timberscombe to Couple Cross Road to Beech Tree (a distance of 2089 metres)
Churchtown to Beech Tree Road	From its junction with Charget Lane to its junction with Couple Cross to Beech Tree Road (a distance of 721 metres)

SCHEDULE 2

Temporary Prohibition of Motor Vehicles between the hours of 0600 on Friday the 7th April 2017 and 2000 hours on Saturday the 8th April 2017

Warren Road, From its junction with Seaward Way to its junction with The
Minehead Esplanade (a distance of 510 metres)

SCHEDULE 3

Map Tiles to be temporarily revoked between the hours of 0600 on Friday the 7th April 2017 and 2000 hours on Saturday the 8th April 2017

Warren Road, Parking restrictions between The Esplanade and Seaward Way
Minehead (Map Tile Numbers BK91 and BK92)
