

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL DISTRICT OF SOUTH SOMERSET PARISH OF HIGH HAM Temporary Closure of Public Right Of Way

TAKE NOTICE that in pursuance of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, has approved an extension to the above Order for a period of four years from 16 April 2017 until 16 April 2021 or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier.

The original Order came into effect on 16 October 2014 at the request of Somerset County Council's Rights of Way Team as the bridge is in danger of collapse.

The Order prohibits all traffic from proceeding along part of footpath L 12/17 from its junction with Wagg Drove to its junction with footpaths L 13/10 and L 13/4 totalling a distance of approximately 90 metres due to the likelihood of danger to the public
