

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL
(A39 THE DROVE AND WYLDs ROAD)
(PARISH OF BRIDGWATER)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council intends to make an order in pursuance of the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of motor vehicles as detailed in the schedule below.

The Order will be made to facilitate resurfacing works and is in the interest of public safety.

The Order becomes effective on the 23rd May 2017 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works will now commence on Monday 5th June 2017 for 7 nights between the hours of 19:00 – 07:00. The restriction will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
