Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council intends to make an order in pursuance of the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a Temporary No Waiting at any time Order as detailed in the schedule below.

This Order shall come into operation on the 27th July 2017 and shall remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions shall only apply when indicated by traffic signs and could be imposed at any time during the eighteen month period.

This Order will facilitate access for local bus services using Market Place as an alternative route whilst Somerset County Council carry out highway works on normal bus route 77 proposed dates for works are as follows 7th August 2017 to 1st September 2017.

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 27<sup>th</sup> July 2017 and shall remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions shall only apply when indicated by traffic signs and could be imposed at any time during the eighteen month period.

This Order will facilitate access for local bus services using Market Place as an alternative route whilst Somerset County Council carry out highway works on normal bus route 77 proposed dates for works are as follows 7<sup>th</sup> August 2017 to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017

2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer, or a Parking Attendant employed by the Local Authority, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of road or in the lengths of road specified in the schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the side/s of road or in the length/s of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary:

(a) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely: -

- (i) building, industrial or demolition operations
- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road or lengths of road, or
- (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to, the said sides of the road or lengths of the road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.

(b) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
