

**THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF SOMERSET (MARKET PLACE, FROME) (LOADING BAY) ORDER 2017 AND (KING STREET, FROME) (ON-STREET PARKING BAYS) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017.**

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

This Order shall come into operation on the 10th day of August 2017 and shall remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to start on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 2017 and to last for 17 weeks until the 30th day of November 2017.

**SCHEDULE 1**  
**Temporary Suspension of Parking Bays**

King Street, Frome	The twenty minute limited waiting bay outside The Iron Gates for its entire length (not including the Taxi Rank) for a distance of 20 metres in a south easterly direction
Market Place, Frome	The designated disabled parking bay outside the George Hotel for a distance of 24 metres in an easterly direction (between the hours of 06:30 – 09:00)

**Temporary Loading Bay Area in Which Only Loading or Unloading is Permitted**

Market Place, Frome	The designated disabled parking bay outside the George Hotel for a distance of 24 metres in an easterly direction (between the hours of 06:30 – 09:00)
King Street, Frome	The twenty minute limited waiting bay outside The Iron Gates for its entire length (not including the Taxi Rank) for a distance of 20 metres in a south easterly direction.

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

**PART I**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 10th day of August 2017 and shall remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to start on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 2017 and to last for 17 weeks until the 30th day of November 2017.

2. Any existing waiting restriction or loading and unloading Orders relating to the lengths of roads specified in Schedules 1 and 2 below are hereby temporarily revoked.

No person shall park any motor vehicle in the locations outside the permitted hours specified in Schedule 1 to this order.

No person shall use the loading bay outside the permitted hours as specified in Schedule 2 to this order outside the permitted hours.

3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

“loading bay area” means the part of the road authorised by this Order to be used as a loading and unloading only area and indicated by sign diagram 660.4 as defined in Schedule 2 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

“permitted hours” in relation to the amendment to the on-street parking places means the period specified in Schedule 1 in this Order

“permitted hours” in relation to the loading bay area means the period specified in Schedule 2 in this Order.

4. THIS Order shall come into operation on the 10<sup>th</sup> August 2017 and may be cited as the County Council of Somerset (Market Place, Frome) (Loading Bay) Order 2017 and (King Street, Frome) (On-Street Parking Bays) Temporary Order 2017.

## **PART II**

### **AUTHORISATION OF USE OF LOADING BAY AREA**

1. In this Order, the existing Disabled Parking Bays in Market Place will be suspended between the hours of 06:30 and 09:00 to enable loading and unloading
2.
  - (i) The part of the road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a loading bay area, for all classes of vehicle, in such positions and on such days and during the permitted hours 06:30 – 09:00 as specified in relation to that part of the road in the said Schedule 2 for the purposes of loading and unloading only.
  - (ii) Nothing in paragraph 3(i) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council to close any loading bay area.
  - (iii) Nothing in paragraph 3(i) of this Article shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait in the loading bay area specified in that paragraph if the vehicle is being used:-
    - a) In the service of the local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
    - b) In the service of the Police Authority; Fire Brigade or Ambulance Service in case of emergency; or
    - c) In connection with any building operation, or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.
3. The driver of any vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a loading bay area for longer than is necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from a vehicle.
4. The driver of a vehicle shall not wait in a loading bay area:-
  - a) So as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance;
