SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

PART I

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 10th day of August 2017 and shall remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to start on the 7th day of August 2017 and to last for 17 weeks until the 30th day of November 2017.

2. Any existing waiting restriction or loading and unloading Orders relating to the lengths of roads specified in Schedules 1 and 2 below are hereby temporarily revoked.

No person shall park any motor vehicle in the locations outside the permitted hours specified in Schedule 1 to this order.

No person shall use the loading bay outside the permitted hours as specified in Schedule 2 to this order outside the permitted hours.

3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"loading bay area" means the part of the road authorised by this Order to be used as a loading and unloading only area and indicated by sign diagram 660.4 as defined in Schedule 2 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"permitted hours" in relation to the amendment to the on-street parking places means the period specified in Schedule 1 in this Order

"permitted hours" in relation to the loading bay area means the period specified in Schedule 2 in this Order.

4. THIS Order shall come into operation on the 10th August 2017 and may be cited as the County Council of Somerset (Market Place, Frome) (Loading Bay) Order 2017and (King Street, Frome) (On-Street Parking Bays) Temporary Order 2017.

PART II

AUTHORISATION OF USE OF LOADING BAY AREA

- 1. In this Order, the existing Disabled Parking Bays in Market Place will be suspended between the hours of 06:30 and 09:00 to enable loading and unloading
- 2. (i) The part of the road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a loading bay area, for all classes of vehicle, in such positions and on such days and during the permitted hours 06:30 09:00 as specified in relation to that part of the road in the said Schedule 2 for the purposes of loading and unloading only.
 - (ii) Nothing in paragraph 3(i) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council to close any loading bay area.
 - (iii) Nothing in paragraph 3(i) of this Article shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait in the loading bay area specified in that paragraph if the vehicle is being used:
 - a) In the service of the local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - b) In the service of the Police Authority; Fire Brigade or Ambulance Service in case of emergency; or
 - c) In connection with any building operation, or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.
- 3. The driver of any vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a loading bay area for longer than is necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from a vehicle.
- 4. The driver of a vehicle shall not wait in a loading bay area:
 - a) So as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance:

- b) When for preventing obstruction of the loading bay area on a particular day or for a particular purpose the Council has closed that loading bay area and exhibited notice of such closing in or near the loading bay area.
- 5. No person shall use a vehicle while it is in the loading bay area, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the loading bay area, or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.
- 6. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a vehicle is left in the loading bay area in contravention of any of the provisions contained in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that loading bay area provided that when a vehicle is waiting in the loading bay area in contravention of the provisions of Article 4 of this Order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
- 7. Any person removing a vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Article 6 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such manner as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.
- 8. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a loading bay area by virtue of Article 6 of this Order, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
