NOTICE is hereby given that Somerset County Council proposes to make the above Order in pursuance of the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary 40 mph speed limit on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The Order is required to facilitate highway works and is necessary for the safety of the workforce whilst carrying out their duties. The restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs

The Order becomes effective on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 2017 and will remain in force for eighteen months.

The works are expected to start on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 2017 at 08:00 and to last until the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 2017 at 16:00.

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

- 1 This Order shall come into operation on the 10th day of August 2017 and shall remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions may not be effected for the whole period but it is anticipated that the restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs

The works are expected to start on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 2017 at 08:00 and to last for until the 13th day of August 2017 at 16:00.

- 2 This order is required to facilitate highway works and is necessary for the safety of the workforce whilst carrying out their duties.
- 3 No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
- 4 This Order shall be cited as the SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL DRULEY HILL, NORTH BREWHAM, BRUTON TEMPORARY 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2017

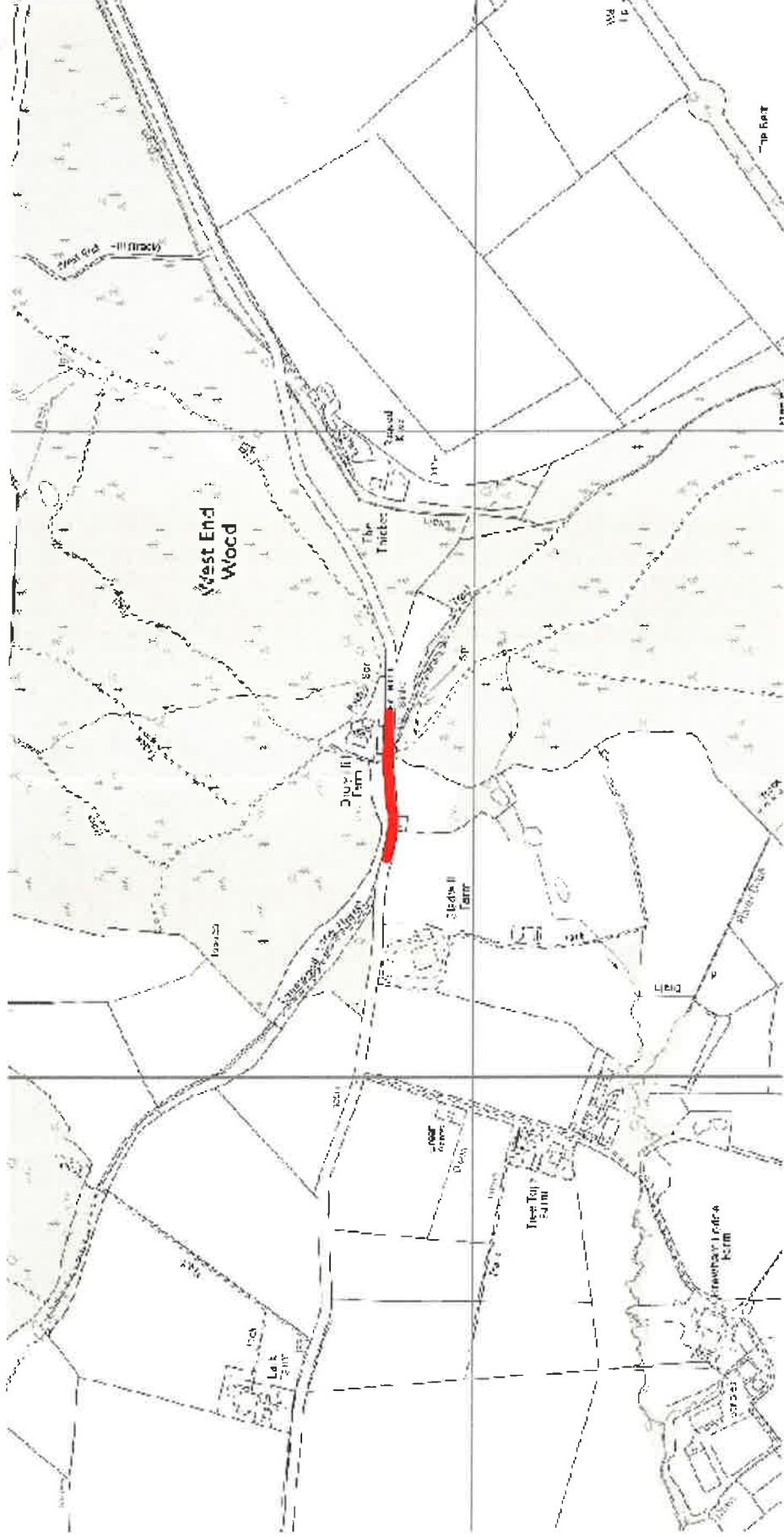
