ORDER 2017

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of a straight-ahead manoeuvre in the road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice and a prohibition of right turn the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in the road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Notice from making a right turn into the road specified in column 2 of the said Schedule. The restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to start on the 12th day of December 2017 and to last until the 31st day of March 2018.

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 12th day of December 2017 and shall remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to carry out a straight-ahead manoeuvre on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
 - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
 - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to turn right into Eastover, as specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order, from Monmouth Street, Bridgwater, as specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
5. The works are expected to start on the 12th day of December 2017 and to last until the 31st day of March 2018.
6. This Order may be cited as "Somerset County Council (Monmouth Street, St John Road and Eastover, Bridgwater) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2017".
