ORDER 2018


SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 22nd day of March 2018 and shall remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in schedule 1 to this Order
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
 - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
 - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.

The works are expected to start on the 26th day of March 2018 until the 29th day of March 2018.

4. This Order may be cited as Somerset County Council, The Crescent, Taunton (Temporary Lane Closure) Order 2018

Temporary Lane Closure

The Crescent
Taunton
(East Side)

From a point 20 metres south of the junction with St. George's Place for a distance of 40 metres in a southerly direction to the junction with Upper High Street.
