ORDER 2018

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers conveyed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on the 17th April 2018 and may be cited as the "Somerset County Council (A39 Cannington Bypass) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 2018"
2. No person except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform shall cause or permit any vehicle to make a right turn from the length of road in column 1 of Schedule 1 into the length of road in column 2.
3. The provisions of any other Order are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this order.

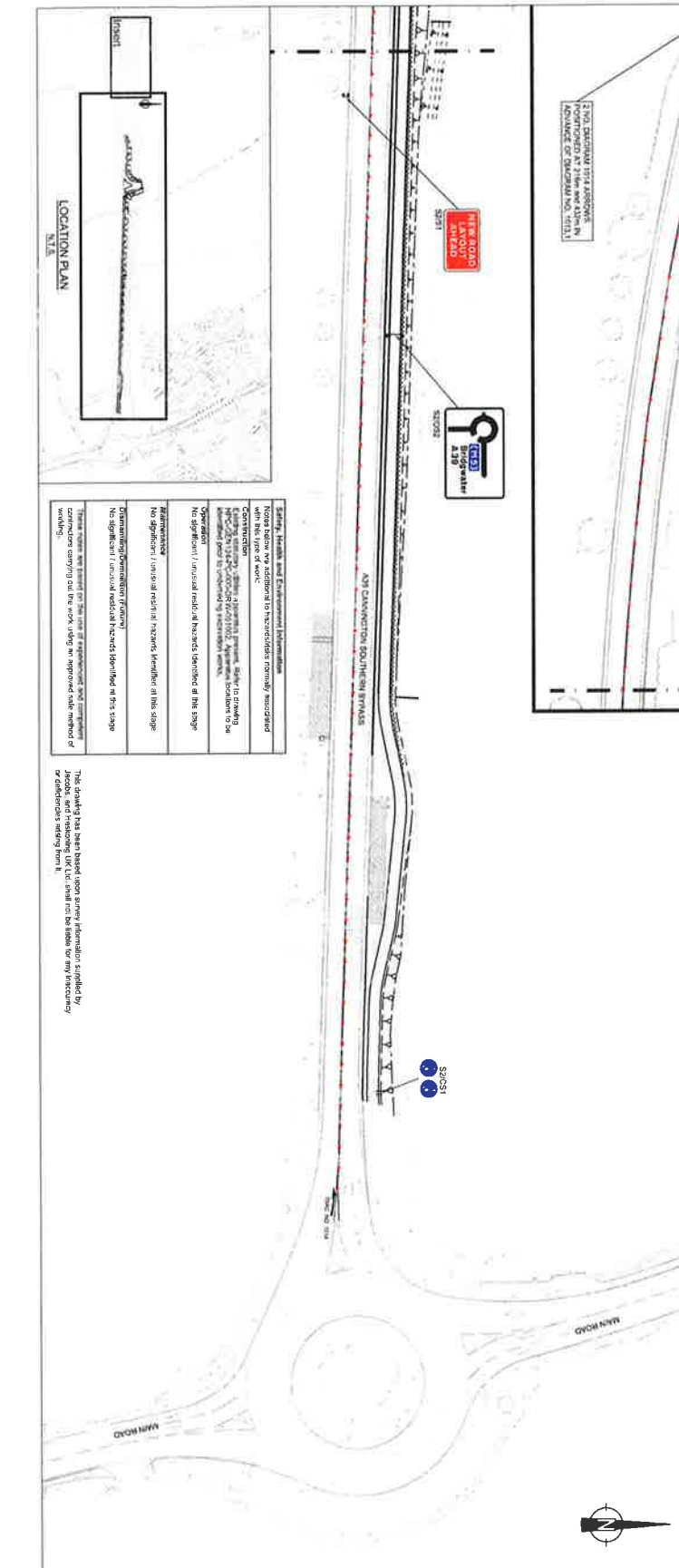
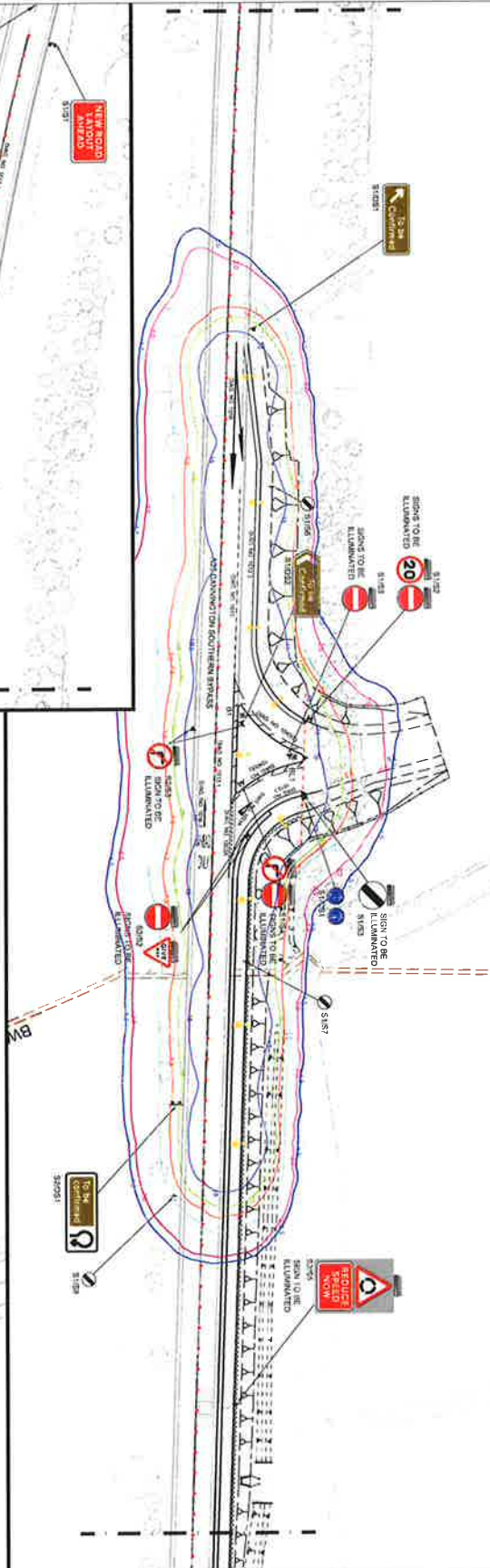
