Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 2004"), as amended, and all other enabling powers; and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

The County of Somerset Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Unloading and On-street Parking Taunton Deane Order 2012 shall be amended by the revocation of the Map Schedule specified in the First Schedule to this Order and the insertion of the Map Schedule specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.

The provisions of the following Orders are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this order.

1. Summary

Proposals to amended parking restrictions at 13 locations across Taunton Deane were advertised on the 22nd March 2018. The proposed Notice is shown in Appendix 1.

A total of **two** objections were received during the consultation period: Both of these were for the proposals in **Admiralty Way, Taunton**.

A copy of the plan of the proposed parking restrictions for Admiralty Way is shown in Appendix 2.

The reason for advertising this proposal is to address safety concerns at the junction into Asda car park. Parked cars along Admiralty Way opposite this junction are having the effect of narrowing the carriageway at this point which means that a safe turning movement for vehicles entering and exiting Asda car park is impeded, making this manoeuvre difficult and dangerous.

2. Recommendations

2.1 It is recommended that the **PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING AND ON-STREET PARKING. TAUNTON DEANE ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT NO. 17) ORDER 2018** be approved.

3.0 Proposed Traffic Regulation Orders

3.1 The Notice (shown in Appendix 1) was advertised in the Somerset County

straight. There's a pavement and crossing for pedestrians and any driver can slow down/stop until it is safe to pass. I fail to see where any sensible person can go wrong."

Response: Acknowledgments were sent to the objector informing them that their feedback will be given consideration.

It is **recommended to approve** the proposals as advertised to protect the safety of the public using this junction.
