SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (MEMBERS ALLOWANCES) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2003 (AS AMENDED) SCHEME OF MEMBERS' ALLOWANCES 2018/19

At its meeting on 21 February 2018, the County Council considered within the MTFP 2018/19 report the proposed approach for the Scheme of Members Allowances 2018/19. The report confirmed that Council had approved a revised Scheme of Members' Allowances in July 2017 following the election of the new Council. The changes made reflected the revised governance arrangements of the Council and included an indexing provision linking increases in the Basic Allowance and Special Responsibility Allowances to officer pay awards. This mechanism would be applied automatically when the officer pay award for 2018/19 is agreed. Beyond this, the Joint Independent Remuneration Panel did not recommend any changes to the Council's Scheme so the current Scheme would continue to apply for 2018/19 with the figures updated as necessary to reflect the pay award.

In summary the scheme makes provision for the payment of the following allowances:

- A Basic Allowance to all councillors in recognition of their normal duties as a councillor of £10,795pa. The Scheme retains the current basis for the calculation and indexing of the Basic Allowance aligned to the County Council's officers' pay scale to maintain the relationship between officers pay and members allowances.
- Special Responsibility Allowances (SRAs) for members undertaking roles with a specific responsibility such as the Leader of Council, Chair of Council, Cabinet Member, Junior Cabinet Member, Opposition Spokesperson, or a committee chairman.
- Travel and subsistence allowances for any duty undertaken as a councillor that falls under the list of approved duties contained within the Scheme.
- Carers' Allowances where appropriate.
