However, should the County Council decide to make an order, the necessary work to publish and defend it at public inquiry will be undertaken by the Council.

It is important for the applicant to be aware that in investigating Definitive Map modification claims, the County Council, as Surveying Authority, is under a duty to record the true status of the way concerned. The evidence may reveal that the claimed way is a: -

- Public Footpath which may be used by members of the public on foot
- Public Bridleway which may be used by walkers, horse riders and cyclists
- Restricted Byway (termally called a Road Used as a Public Pa.h) which may be used by all the above and horse drawn cares or carriages
- Byway Open to All Traffic (BOAT) which may be used by all the above and mechanically propelled vehicles

Similarly, following research, the investigating officer may conclude that the way is shown correctly on the records or has no public rights at all.
