I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Upgrading to a bridleway the route known as Wood Lane in Aller (footpath L 1/13) the footpath in High Ham (L12 /33) which runs southwards from Turnhill Road along the western side of Breech Wood, and then westwards to Bere Road, Aller to be shown as bridleway. Also the original line of the earlier route (line A) from Standhill Road to the above described route to be shown as a bridleway.

Line A is a dogleg line from Standhill Road, approximately 41638 31376, to the point on the application route opposite Turn Hill Farm at 41188 31241.

Line B extends from opposite the entrance to the National Trust property at Turnhill Road at 41400 31548 in a straight line to 41188 31241 which is a continuation of Wood Lane, and from where line A originally took the route on the dog leg course to connect with Standhill Road.
