Adding the route in Muchelney running from the north eastern end of the restricted byway known as Horsey Lane at ST 4347 2550 (point E), extending eastwards along Chambers Drove ST 4367 2551 (point D) and to continue on around northwards to ST 4397 2607 (point F) to Pibsbury ford, ST 4371 2619 (point G) and across the River Yeo (Ivel) to the public road in Pibsbury ST 4371 2628 (point H) to be shown as a restricted byway.

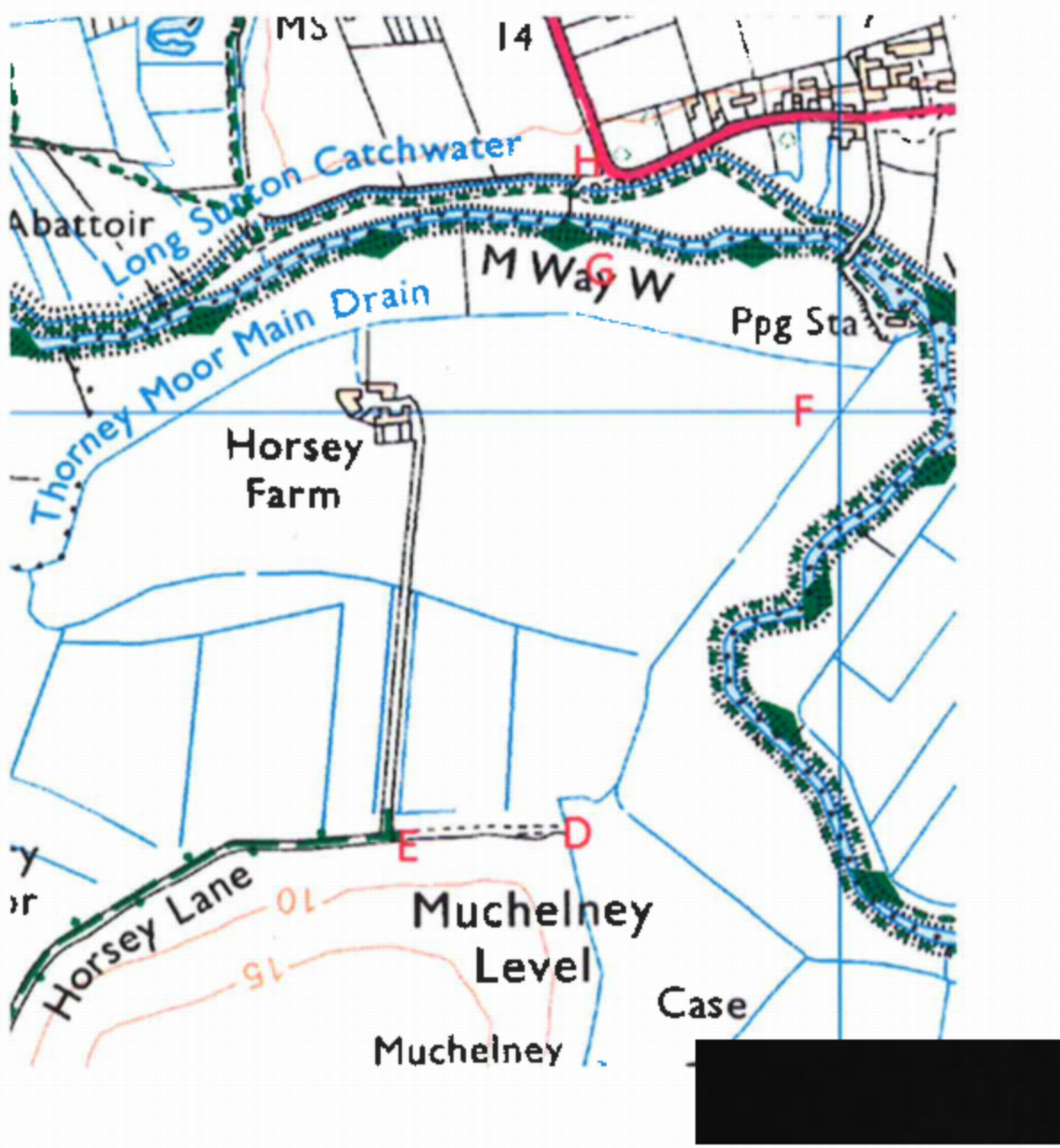
