I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the South Somerset Bridleways Association, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Adding the restricted byway which runs from point A, the junction with the Brewham Road leading east out of Bruton (ST 6882 3515) southwards to point B, a short distance south of the bridge over the River Bruc (ST 6889 3488), then westwards to point C (ST 6869 3479) where it joins the road serving the car park at Bruton station and shown on the map accompanying this application.
