THE COUNTY OF SOMERSET PROHIBITION AND
RESTRICTION OF STOPPING, WAITING,
LOADING AND UNLOADING AND ON-STREET PARKING
SEDGEMOOR ORDER 2012
(AMENDMENT NO. 11) ORDER 2018

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as the Council) in exercise of its powers under Section 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984'); and all other enabling powers; and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

1. This order shall come into force on 11th September 2018 and may be cited as

"Restricted Parking Zones (Prohibition of Waiting and On-Street Parking) Sedgemoor 2012 (Amendment No. 11) Order 2018"
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Constable in uniform, or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform, or with the permission of a Parking Attendant employed by the Council, drive, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed or wait in the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to :-
 - i. any vehicle requiring access to private access and egress to private land;
 - ii. any vehicle used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to, or the laying erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the laid lengths of road of any sewer, or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any apparatus as defined in Paragraph 1 (1) if the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - iii. any vehicle used for the purpose of delivery or collecting of postal packets as defined in Schedule 87 of the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - iv. any vehicle used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes;
 - v. any vehicle in order to gain access for the purpose of loading and unloading goods in connection with the business carried out at those premises , provided that this article shall only apply to :-

- i. vehicles in the course of trade or business delivering or collecting goods or merchandise which because of its bulky nature requires to be loaded or unloaded close to the premises;
or
- ii. purpose made high security vehicles.
- vi. any vehicle that needs to gain access for the purposes of loading and unloading goods or setting up or taking down stalls in connection with street trading activities that have been duly authorised by the Council.
- vii. any vehicle to facilitate street trading activities from a stationary vehicle which has been duly authorised by the Council.
- viii. Any vehicle in order to gain access for the purpose of special activities, such as street entertainment, charitable collections, exhibitions or promotional events, which have been approved by the Council.

4. For the purposes of Articles 2(vi), 2(vii) and 2 (viii), authorisation for vehicles to proceed, wait, load and unload may be given by Sedgemoor District Council in respect of activities and events authorised or approved by the Council.

5. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent the delivery or collection of goods from or by a vehicle, in connection with the businesses carried out at those premises listed in Schedule 2 to this Order, provided that this Article shall only apply to:-

- i. vehicles in the course of trade or business delivering or collecting goods or merchandise which because of its bulky nature requires that it be loaded or unloaded close to the premises, or:
- ii. purpose made high security vehicles.

6. Any existing Traffic Regulation Orders relating to the roads and areas specified in Schedule 1 to this order are hereby revoked.

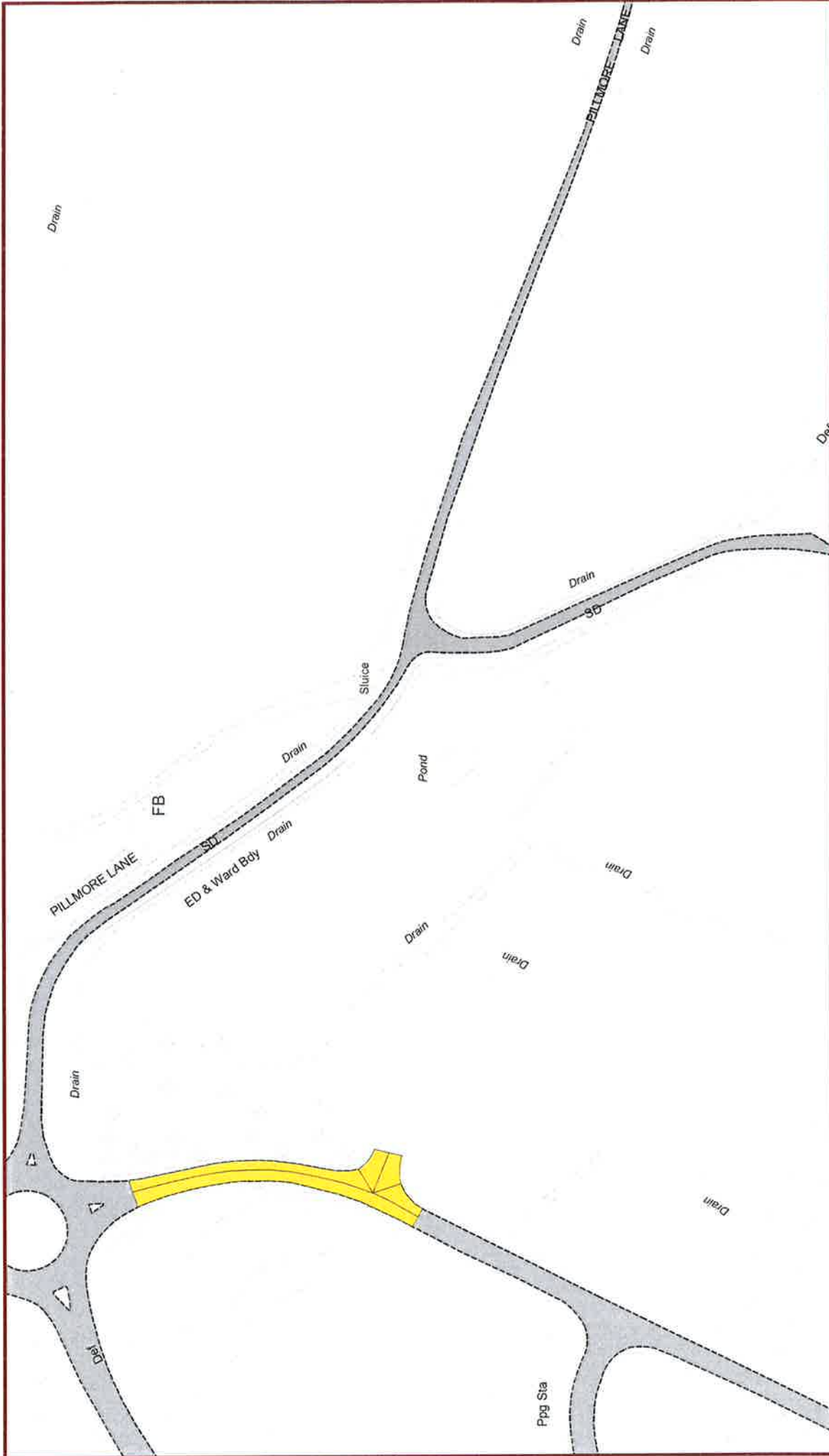


