**NOTICE OF INTENT TO
INTRODUCE A CYCLE TRACK ALONG HALESLEIGH ROAD, CORONATION
ROAD AND VICTORIA ROAD, BRIDGWATER
AND
WEMBDON ROAD AND HALESLEIGH ROAD, BRIDGWATER**

Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council in accordance with Sections 65 and 66 of the Highways Act 1980 propose a cycle link between Wembdon Road and Halesleigh Road and between Halesleigh Road, Coronation Road and Victoria Road, Bridgwater.

**SCHEDULE
Provision of a Cycle Track**

1. The cycle track on Victoria Road will be 3.65 metres wide and commence from the eastern end of the public footpath BW38/10. The existing footway will be a shared, unsegregated footway/cycleway 2.65 metres in length.
2. The cycle track on Wembdon Road will be 4.4 metres wide and commence from the southern end of public footpath BW38/11. The existing footway will be a shared, unsegregated footway/cycleway 9.5 metres in length.
