TAKE NOTICE that in pursuance of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended, the County Council of Somerset propose to make an Order PROHIBITING ALL TRAFFIC from proceeding along

Kennel Lane, Compton Bishop – for its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is 10th January 2019 for 7 days.

Eastfield Lane, West Stoughton and Ashton (Stoughton Cross), Wedmore – From its junction with Ashtone Grove to its junction with Stoughton Road, a distance of 920 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 14th March 2019 for 6 days.

Sparrow Hill Way, Weare – From its junction with Notting Hill Way to its junction with Alston Sutton Road, a distance of 950 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **14**th **March 2019 for 15 days.**

Ashton Road, Ashton, Chapel Allerton– From its junction with Rawlings Lane to its junction with Ashton Drove, a distance of 770 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **20**th **March 2019 for 10 days.**

Alston Sutton Road, Weare – From its junction with Brinscombe Lane, to its junction with Alston Sutton Lane, a distance of 1005 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **29**th **March 2019 for 13 days.**

This order will enable Gigaclear to carry out a rolling programme of underground cabling works with clearing of potential duct (pipe) blockages in this road.

The Order becomes effective on **25th December 2018** and will remain in force for eighteen months. While the closure is in operation an alternative route will be signed as detailed below.

This Order is required to facilitate highway works and is necessary for the safety of the workforce whilst carrying out their duties. The restriction shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
