Western Lane, Priddy – Junction with West Harptree Road to Junction with Smitham's Hill, a distance of 1896 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **14**th **January 2019 for 4 days.**

Latches Lane, Cheddar– Junction with Nyland Farm approach to Junction of Court Farm Approach, a distance of 125 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 1st February 2019 for 6 days.

Lane between Middle Stoughton and Stoughton Cross, Wedmore – Intersection with Lane Between West Stoughton and Middle Stoughton to Junction of Lascot Hill, a distance of 400 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 1st February 2019 for 10 days.

Notting Hill Way, Chapel Allerton– Junction with Quab Lane to Junction with Rawlings Lane, a distance of 995 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 1st **May 2019 for 7 days.**

Millway Road, Rodney Stoke—Junction of Wells Road and Millway to Junction of Stoke Street and Millway, a distance of 500 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 2nd May 2019 for 5 days.

This order will enable Gigaclear to carry out a rolling programme of underground cabling works with clearing of potential duct (pipe) blockages in this road.

The Order becomes effective on **10**th **January 2019** and will remain in force for eighteen months. While the closure is in operation an alternative route will be signed as detailed below.

This Order is required to facilitate highway works and is necessary for the safety of the workforce whilst carrying out their duties. The restriction shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
