Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council intends to make an order in pursuance of the provisions of Section 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of motor vehicles as detailed in the schedule below.

The Order will be made to facilitate the Hestercombe Humdinger and Hurtle Road Run and is in the interest of public safety. All closures will be signed and staffed and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.

The Order shall come into operation at 1030 hours and will continue in force until 1145 hours on the 10<sup>th</sup> February 2018.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for emergency vehicles, residents requiring access and egress to Pyrland Fields and any vehicles associated with the event.

The County of Somerset in exercise of their powers under Section 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into effect on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2018 will remain in force for a period not exceeding 18 months and may be cited as ‘Somerset County Council (Cheddon Road, Taunton) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2019 (The Hestercombe Humdinger).’
2. The Order shall come into operation at 1030 hours on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2019 and will continue in force until 1145 hours on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2019. The restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall:
  - (i) Cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.
3. Nothing in Article 2 and 3 of this Order shall apply to:
  - i. Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
  - ii. Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
  - iii. Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
  - iv. any vehicle being used for the purpose of maintenance of the road and operations; maintenance of street furniture and infrastructure; supply of gas, water or electricity; agriculture on any land adjacent;
