The Order will come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> February 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restriction will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

- 1. Except as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the length of road specified in the Schedules 1 Order,
- 2. The two-way system is temporarily revoked on the length of roads specified in schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 of this Order will apply to:
  - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform:
  - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
  - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
  - 4. This Order may be cited as the Somerset County Council (Owl Street and Silver Street) (Parish of Kingsbury Episcopi) South Somerset (Temporary Lane Closure (East Bound), One-Way Order (West Bound) Order 2019
