Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after communicating with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

This Order will come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The effect of which will be to introduce a Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles in the roads specified in the schedule to this Order. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to start on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 2019

**Schedule  
Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

**Ashton Drove,  
Chapel Allerton**

For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is **20<sup>th</sup> February 2019 for 6 days.**

**Stoughton Road,  
Wedmore**

from its junction of Lime Kiln Lane for a distance of 410 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **26<sup>th</sup> February 2019 for 11 days.**

**Mark Road,  
Chapel Allerton**

from its junction with Front Street to its junction with Blackford Moor Drove, a distance of 1020 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **10<sup>th</sup> April 2019 for 5 days.**

**Notting Hill Way,  
Middle Stoughton**

from its junction with Allerton Lane to its junction of Badgworth Lane, a distance of 930 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **17<sup>th</sup> April 2019 for 9 days.**

**Stoke Street/  
Honeyhurst Lane,  
Rodney Stoke**

from the junction with Butts Lane Junction of Stoke Street and Barrow Lane, a distance of 815 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **22<sup>nd</sup> April 2019 for 10 days.**

**Lascot Hill,  
Wedmore**

from its junction with Lane from Cross to its junction Washbrook, a distance of 1372 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **24<sup>th</sup> April 2019 for 7 days.**

**Weare Road,  
Chapel Allerton**

from its junction with Rectory Hill to its junction with Rawlings Lane, a distance of 480 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **8<sup>th</sup> May 2019 for 7 days.**

**Notting Hill Way,  
Middle Stoughton**

from its junction Sparrow Hill Way to its junction of Badgworth Lane, a distance of 1050 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **15<sup>th</sup> May 2019 for 7 days.**

**Lane between West,  
Middle Stoughton**

from its junction with Eastfield to its junction Stoughton Road, a distance of 225 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **22<sup>nd</sup> May 2019 for 7 days.**

#### **Statement of reasons for making the Order**

- a) Because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road; or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
