I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the South Somerset Bridleways Association, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Upgrading parts of footpaths WN 23/38 and WN 23/40 to bridleway status and adding two sections of bridleway in the parishes of South Barrow, Queen Camel and Sparkford.

The application route runs from South Barrow at the sharp bend in the road north of Hazlegrove House, point A (ST 5990 2734) south eastwards along an enclosed track (part of definitive footpath WN23/40) and continuing on along the parish boundary to point B (ST 6005 2702). It then goes south-eastwards to point C (ST 6019 2683). The route continues south-westwards to point D (ST 6016 2674) (part of definitive footpath WN 23/38) and then southwards to point E (ST 6040 2638) where it comes out to the road alongside where the Cattle Pens used to be located by the Sparkford Inn. Between points D and E the route crosses the A303 Sparkford bypass at grade.

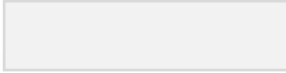
