This Order shall come into operation on the 5th February 2019 and may be cited as 'Somerset County Council, (Cycle Tracks) (Public Footpaths) (BW38/10 between Halesleigh Road, Coronation Road and Victoria Road, Bridgwater) (BW38/11 between Wembdon Road and Halesleigh Road, Bridgwater) Order 2018.

SCHEDULE

Change of status of public footpaths BW38/10 and BW38/11 to convert them to a shared use Cycle Track.

The following length to be used as part of Bridgwater's Cycle Route network

- 1. Public Footpath BW38/11 varying in width from 2.6 metres to 4.4 metres wide for a length of 142 metres
- 2. Public footpath BW38/10 varying in width from 2.6 metres to 3.4 metres wide for a length of 37 metres
