(Temporary 10mph Speed Restriction (Convoy Working)) Order 2019

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary 10mph Speed (Convoy Working) Restriction on the length of road detailed in Schedule 1 of this Order

The Order will come into operation on the 30th May 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works will commence on the 30th May for 5 days. The restriction will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The Order will be made to facilitate construction works and is in the interest of public safety.
