

Somerset County Council
(Various Roads, Taunton, Taunton Deane)
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions) (Special Events) Order 2019
(Cricket World Cup 2019)

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order: -

- a temporary prohibition of vehicles on The Bridge, North Street, Fore Street, East Street, Corporation Street, Castle Green, Tower Street and Castle Way (Schedule 1)
- a temporary prohibition of waiting (Blue Badge Exemption) on Billet Street (Schedule 2)
- a temporary prohibition of waiting, loading and unloading on The Crescent (Schedule 3)
- a temporary prohibition of vehicles on St James Street, Middle Street, Lower Middle Street, Coal Orchard, Canon Street, Priory Avenue, St Augustine Street and Priory Bridge Road (Schedule 4, 5 & 6)

The Order will be made to facilitate the Cricket World Cup 2019 and is in the interest of public safety. All closures will be signed and staffed and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.

The Order shall come into operation at 1900 hours on Friday the 7th of June 2019 and will remain in force until 2000 hours on Monday the 17th of June 2019.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for emergency vehicles and as specified in the Schedules to this Order for Taxis, local buses, event vehicles, loading and unloading and access and egress to the Castle Hotel

The County of Somerset in exercise of their powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following order:

1. This Order will come into effect on the 30th day of May 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. The Order shall come into operation at 1900 hours on Friday the 7th of June 2019 and will remain in force until 2000 hours on Monday the 17th of June 2019.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed or wait in the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order will apply to:
 - i. Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
 - ii. Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
 - iii. Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
 - iv. any vehicle being used for the purpose of maintenance of the road and operations; maintenance of street furniture and infrastructure; supply of gas, water or electricity; agriculture on any land adjacent;
5. Exemptions are provided as specified in the Schedules to this Order for Taxis, local buses, event vehicles and access and egress to the Castle Hotel.
6. Exemption have been provided for access and egress for deliveries between the hours of 0600 and 0900 for all roads specified in Schedule 1
7. This Order may be cited as Somerset County Council (Various Roads, Taunton, Taunton Deane) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) (Special Events) Order 2019 (Cricket World Cup 2019).

- Tower Street, Taunton From its junction with Castle Street to its junction with Castle Way a distance of 95 metres (Taxis, Event Vehicles, access to Castle Hotel and Buses exempt)
- Castle Green, Taunton From its junction with Castle Way to its junction with Castle Bow a distance of 95 metres (Taxis, Event Vehicles, access and egress from Castle Hotel and Buses exempt)
