Temporary Closure of Footpaths L 6/11 AND L 18/8 order 2018

TAKE NOTICE that in pursuance of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, has approved an extension to the above Order for a period of twenty four months from 4 April 2019 to 4 April 2021.

The original Order came into effect on 4 October 2018 at the request of Somerset County Council's Rights of Way Team due to an unsafe bridge. The Order PROHIBITS ALL TRAFFIC from proceeding along Footpath L 6/11 from its junction with the county road known as West Charlton in a westerly direction for approximately 890 metres to the River Cary and its junction with the Footpath L 18/8 and then in a south westerly direction for approximately 920 metres to its junction with the County Road known as Huish Road
