





Somerset Child-Safe Partnership is part of the Somerset Safeguarding Children Board. The Board has a legal duty to work with all organisations, large and small, to keep children in Somerset safe.

The aim of the Child-Safe Partnership is to provide clear child protection and safeguarding guidelines for staff and volunteers who run clubs for children and young people in every community.

The Partnership offers free seminars and there are various seminar options available to your club. To discuss the options and find out more about attending a seminar, please contact the Child-Safe Administrator.

On becoming a member of Child-Safe, your club will be provided with free resource packs that contain Child Protection Policies, advice and guidance for the club organisers and information for parents/carers and children, about the Child-Safe measures the club should have in place.

If you organise/help at a local club, or if your children go to a club nearby, we have confidence that the 'Child-Safe' pack will add to your understanding of the way in which we can all work together to safeguard children. It will also specifically guide you through the steps to take if any form of abuse is discovered or suspected.

The protection of children in Somerset is everyone's responsibility.

This is your opportunity to play a vital part in keeping the children in your community safe.
