The structures that failed were neither of the same stock type (i.e. a mixture of bridges and retaining walls) nor of the same form. It is impossible to quantify how many structures are likely to fail, in part or whole, each year since if we knew this we would have prioritised these sites over other urgent works.

It is not possible to state how much more expensive a repair will become due to lack of maintenance. For example, vegetation removal seems a straightforward activity, but dependent on location can be relatively costly to undertake. The consequence of inadequate vegetation removal could be superficial ivy coverage or structure threatening invasive tree roots. The tasks that some maintenance activities necessitate may also be the same as the consequence of not undertaking scheduled maintenance. For example bearing or joint replacement as part of a scheduled programme has an event cost the same as replacement due to failure. These and other activities, like waterproofing breakdown, may also contribute to the hastened deterioration of adjacent associated or unconnected elements.

The consequence of insufficient water carrying capacity of a structure is dependent on the usage of the land around the site. Wide open levels have a next to nil consequence whereas a town centre bridge would have significant financial burden. The insufficient carrying capacity of a structure is also not always a feature														

justifying improvement. Consequences of increasing structure capacity needs to be considered in respect of passing the problem downstream, perhaps to a more vulnerable, risky or financially problematic area.

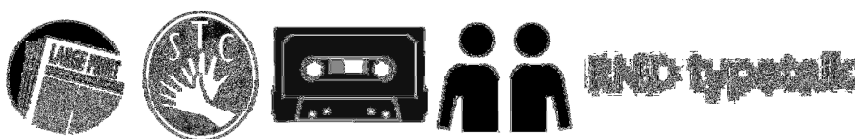
