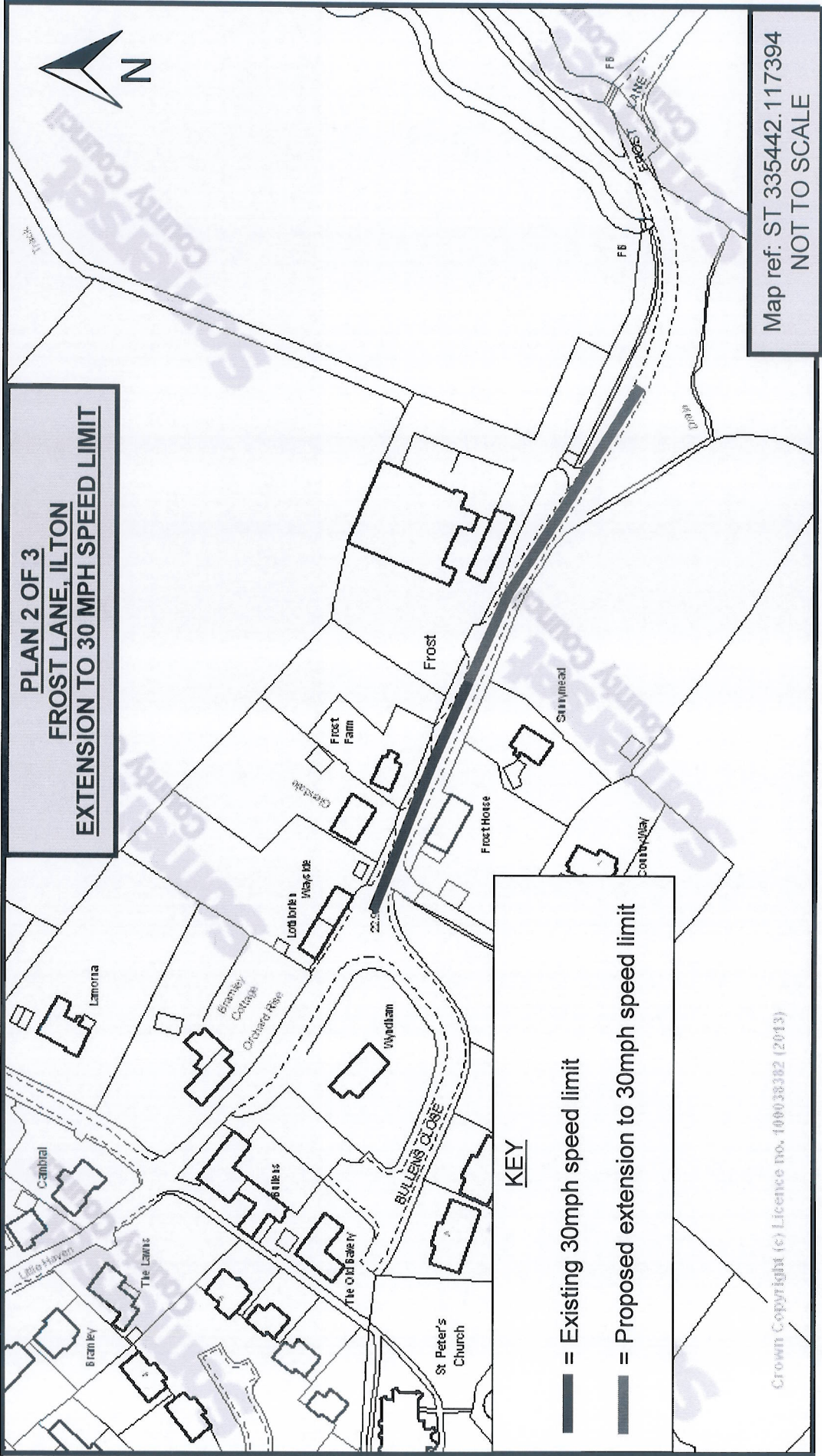

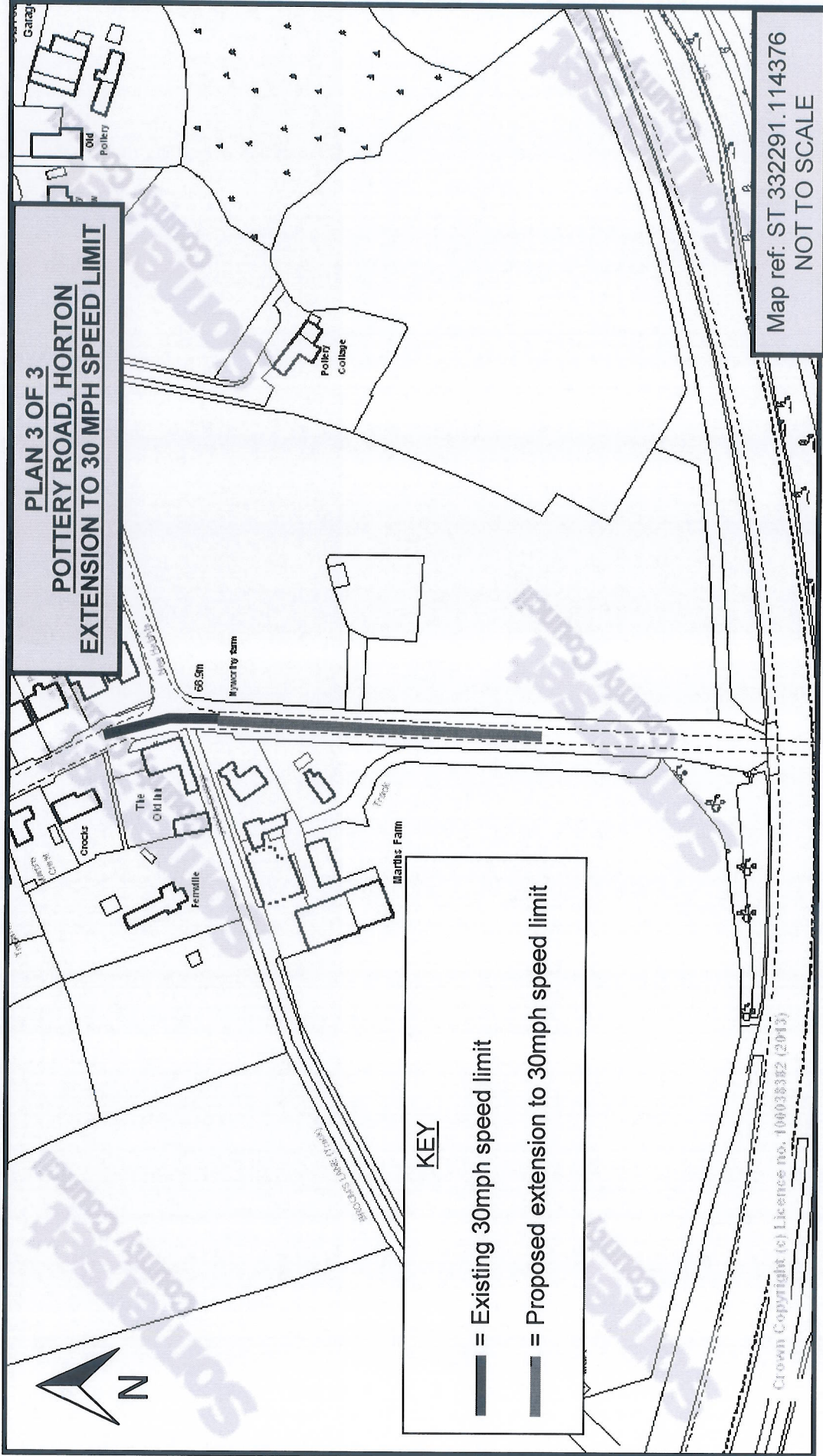

The County Council of Somerset propose to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the effect of which will be to extend the 30 mph speed limits on Rod Lane, Ilton; Frost Lane, Ilton; and Pottery Road, Horton as detailed in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the Order as drafted, a map showing the length of roads affected and a Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the Area Highway Office, Mead Avenue, Houndstone Business Park, Yeovil, during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order may do so in writing specifying the grounds on which it is made to the Area Highway Manager not later than three weeks from the date of this notice.

This Order comes into effect on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2014.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within six weeks from the 17<sup>th</sup> April 2014, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF SOMERSET in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order shall come into operation on the 17<sup>th</sup> April 2014 and may be cited as "The County Council of Somerset (Ilton and Horton, South Somerset) (30 mph Speed Limit Extension) Order 2014".
