**Re: Somerset Minerals Plan Examination – Main Modifications Consultation**

We are making a representation on behalf of our client White Moss Horticulture Ltd. to the Somerset Minerals Plan Examination consultation on the Schedule of Main Modifications. White Moss Horticulture owns and operates an existing peat extraction site and factory at Lewis Drove, Godney.

**Main Modification 13**

We welcome the proposed modification and agree with the text as amended.

The revised wording will provide suitable flexibility to ensure that existing peat sites in Somerset can meet the likely demand for peat over the plan period. This will also take into account potential external constraints, such as flooding, that could significantly delay peat harvesting, resulting in the need for time extensions to existing permissions.

Although we do not wish to make further comments, we also support Main Modifications 14-16, 22 and 36.

We trust that this representation will be forwarded to the Inspector for consideration and are happy to discuss this further if necessary.
